## Abortion: Not your 'blob of tissue' any more

As technology inches forward, and an ever growing number of expectant parents can vividly see their children because of dramatic advances in ultrasound, the pro-abortion crowd has begun focusing on other tactics to convince their prospective clientele that abortion is a good idea.

For example, at the Cincinnati Women's Services clinic, they describe their efforts, including abortion, as "sacred work that honors the circle of life and death." While providing abortion from the 4th through 19th weeks of pregnancy, they claim that they are willing to help women explore all their options.

At George Tiller's abortion clinic in Kansas, where abortions are performed through the eighth month of pregnancy, special remembrances are arranged for those parents who choose to abort a child with a "fetal anomaly," which means a child with serious physical problems. Tiller's web site discusses options for parents who choose to abort their baby, including viewing or holding the child after the abortion is complete.

A small group of abortion providers, known as the November Gang, actually pride themselves on "echoing" the feelings of the woman who chooses abortion — by using words like "baby" — to affirm the woman's feelings prior to her abortion. In other words, more and more abortionists are becoming aware that the public is no longer buying their argument that abortion simply removes a "blob of tissue."

Such death peddlers are trying to convince people that abortion is a loving act, the best thing possible

for the baby and all those involved. As one reporter writes in reference to the November Gang, "when a churchgoing young woman asked whether God will forgive her for 'killing my baby,' the counselor asked, 'Do you think there are any things that God considers completely unforgivable?' A moment later the woman shook her head."

Charlotte Taft, director of an abortion clinic in Dallas, talked with *Glamour* magazine and said, "As women and men and their families take on a sense of honor about this choice, as they realize that it can come from their love and their integrity, that it's not evil or weak or selfish, but that it can be made in a very responsible way, I believe that shifts the entire conversation about abortion."

Pro-life Americans must not only be more aware of this tragic set of circumstances, but must act on it. There is nothing good about killing a baby. There is nothing satisfying about choosing to eliminate a child by denying that the child has a right to live — a right that comes from God. There is certainly no saving grace in making a decision to destroy a human being, regardless of the rhetoric being used.

It is our responsibility to keep the focus on three things: on what abortion does to children, on the fact that mothers are indeed mothers from their children's moment of conception, and on the eternal reality that dastardly acts do send souls to eternal suffering.
