From April 2022, the BGCA OF Shinnecock Nation hosted a partnered discussion with PP: "Please join Planned Parenthood tonight from 7-8pm for a discussion about all things related to raising teens (and pre-teens). This will be a virtual meeting only. Gain knowledge on Planned Parenthood services, digital literacy and develop stronger relationships and support from other parents in your community. We hope to see you there!" Like the Boy and Girl Scouts, the organization allows individual clubs to host, support, and partner with events like these. I have not been able to find any other indication of financial or group participation with PP outside of this one.
