CONTRACEPTION & ABORTION

- In a [January 2023 blog post](#) on its website it mourns the end of Roe v. Wade:
"By criminalizing abortion and pregnancy outcomes, these bans contribute further to criminalizing women, girls, nonbinary folk (sic), trans men, and intersex people, especially those of color, for making the personal choice that is best for them."

"AGF is lifting up the work of members who are on the frontlines of reproductive justice. . . . our member organizations, HEART, National Center for Youth Law (NCYL), and Planned Parenthood Mar Monte."
