#### **ABORTION & CONTRACEPTION**

- Amnesty International's national campaign, "My Body, My Rights" explicitly
  advocates for abortion and contraception. A 2017 toolkit lists the issues the
  pro-abortion movement was facing at the time under the political threats
  in the US to their "rights and access" to abortion and contraception. It also
  recommends support for all the top abortion groups, such as Planned
  Parenthood, Reproductive Freedom for All (formerly known as NARAL), and
  Center for Reproductive Rights.
- Amnesty's <u>official press release</u> on the one-year anniversary of the overturning of Roe v. Wade:

"Abortion is a human right and basic healthcare, and activists across the country and around the world are more determined than ever to ensure that people across the USA will be able to access this right."

It refers to women as "people who can become pregnant" throughout the publication.

- In a August <u>2023 press release</u>, Amnesty claims that "reproductive rights information" is being censored on social media and throughout the Internet.
   This is very interesting, as this "information" is not only easily accessible but heavily promoted all over the Internet and Google results.
- Amnesty <u>called for Congress</u> to urgently "pass legislation to protect abortion rights."
- · Amnesty's discuses its abortion advocacy in Poland.
- Amnesty alleges "reproductive rights activists" are <u>facing more harassment on X</u> since the overturning of Roe v. Wade and that X needs to prevent that.
- Amnesty's official statement on June 24, 2022, when the U.S. Supreme Court overturned Roe v. Wade:

"People will be forced to give birth. They'll be forced to seek unsafe abortions. This is the outcome of a decades-long campaign to control the bodies of women, girls, and people who can become pregnant. And it paves the way for unprecedented state legislation to criminalize abortion, as well as other bills that will aim to strip human rights from people in the United States, including the potential for bills that will affect access to birth control, gender, and marriage equality, as well as other anti-discrimination laws."

- Amnesty USA publishes "Sexual & Reproductive Rights" to explain its position on abortion access.
- Amnesty International's 2021 Annual Report:

"Amnesty International strives to create a world where the human rights of women, LGBTI+ individuals, and Indigenous peoples are protected, and in which all individuals can enjoy their sexual and reproductive rights."

It also brags about the advocacy and campaigning it did to end "the Global Gag Rule," which the House of Representatives repealed in 2021 with the HER Act.

Amnesty International advocates for not only the inclusion, but the promotion and acceptance of all LGBTQ+ beliefs from the
government and public to end discrimination towards those who identify with the agenda. It <u>states on its website</u> under "LGBTQI+
Rights":

"WHAT IS THE SOLUTION? -Protect the rights and lives of LGBTQI+ people. Governments must implement comprehensive frameworks for protecting the rights of LGBTQI+ people, not only decriminalizing marginalized gender identities but also ensuring equal and full access to healthcare and protections from discrimination in policing, housing, employment, and **all other aspects of life**."

This page also advertises their "LGBTQI+ Glossary" for people to educate themselves on the letterings.

- · Amnesty promotes the LGBTQ+ agenda, specifically a transgender agenda, on young people.
- Amnesty's USA National Director for Programs, Tarah Demant, <u>condemned the U.S. House</u> for passing an anti-transgender youth bill in April of 2023:

"The bill purports to protect the rights of women by restricting the rights of transgender students from playing on women's or girls' sports teams and seeking to amend federal law to redefine sex as being recognized solely on a person's reproductive biology and genetics at birth. **Transgender women are women**, and legislation that seeks to curtail their rights or erase them does not in any way protect cisgender women."
