 In 2013, the University of Nebraska Medical Center <u>published guidelines for a stem</u> <u>cell research project</u> that includes the following statement on **not allowing human embryonic stem cell research** in the project. Boys Town's National Research Hospital is included in their list of institutions that do not allow this type of research:

"Sponsoring Institution. Proposals for funding may be submitted by an institution in Nebraska that has an ongoing, large-scale research program that is conducive to the completion of a complex project in stem cell research that **does not use human embryonic stem cells** (e.g., the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, Creighton University, the University of Nebraska Medical Center, and Boys Town's National Research Hospital)."

ABORTION & CONTRACEPTION

• In 2011, Father Steven Boes, Boys Town CEO at the time, <u>wrote a letter protesting the government's mandate</u> for Boys Town and other organizations to adhere to President Obama's pro-abortion/pro-contraception HHS mandate:

"We urge HHS... to rescind the Mandate altogether, or, at the very least, exempt all stakeholders with a religious or moral objection to 'contraceptives' (including abortificients, as well as non-abortifacient mechanisms of action), sterilization, and related education and counseling, from having to provide, offer, pay for, or in any way participate in health insurance that includes such coverage. The right to religious and expressive freedom requires no less."
