· AFG's CEO, Amy Good, says in a 2014 interview with Metro Times that AFG works with young women:

"We help them avoid violence, pregnancy, and exploitation."

- Pregnancy is listed on <u>AFG's website</u> (archived) under "Prevention." However, AFG does not specify what it does to "help prevent teenage pregnancy."
- In 2018, AFG added CEO of The Skillman Foundation, Carol Goss, to page 27 of its "role model" list. Carol Goss was serving as a board member for Planned Parenthood of Michigan at the time of the nomination by AFG. She remains listed as a board member of Planned Parenthood of Michigan.
- In 2013 a blogger attending AFG's "New Choices", a program within AFG's "Safe Choice" project, writes about the program's features. She says it includes the following:

"New Choices has a vast array of services: from the clothing closet, to condom packets, with daily transportation, hot lunches, and shower and laundry facilities-New Choices participants receive a lot of services!"

• In a chat conversation through AFG's website on 5/24/2024, an anonymous staff member responded to ALL's question regarding whether it provides information on contraception and abortion in its teen pregnancy program. The response was: "Yes, we do have pamphlets and educational materials as well as condoms."
