 The Hunger Project promotes and <u>provides female condoms</u> as a means of preventing HIV/AIDS:

"Distribute female condoms. We inform women in Malawi to take control of their sexual and reproductive health with the distribution of female condoms at epicenter health centers."

 The Hunger Project <u>features a story</u> about one of its leaders who began a doorto-door initiative to provide women with contraceptives during the COVID-19 pandemic:

"One such local leader, Aisha Nanfuka, a 45-year-old mother of four daughters in Uganda, activated an innovative network of women volunteers that arranged door-to-door delivery of contraceptives and antiretroviral therapy along with gynecological care for the people of their community throughout the lockdown... They collected data on the community's health and ensured the continued distribution of oral contraceptive pills to women in the community who had previously registered for care and distributed antiretrovirals to HIV+ clients who couldn't walk the long distances to the health center.



With funding from the Else-Kroner Fresenius Foundation we have commenced the training of health workers on the removal and insertion of birth control implants. They have been taken through various modules on family planning and also equipped with the skills sets to be able to perform the removal and insertion of Jadelle and Impanon NXT."
