- A [press release from January 2017](#) shows Wounded Warrior Project “applauds” the Department of Veterans Affairs for going to Congress and making sure wounded veterans and all veterans would have access to IVF.

“Wounded Warrior Project® (WWP) applauds swift action by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to help wounded veterans wishing to start a family.

...

In addition to fertility treatment already offered, VA will provide coverage for assisted reproductive technologies including in vitro fertilization (IVF) to veterans who lost the ability to procreate because of a service-connected injury. They will also provide the treatment to spouses of veterans with those injuries.”

*“Wounded Warrior Project® (WWP) urges the House Appropriations Committee to support a measure that would allow the Department of Veterans’ Affairs (VA) to continue providing fertility coverage for wounded veterans and their families. **WWP has long advocated this coverage, which would help nearly 2,000 veterans start or grow their families.**”*
