ABORTION & CONTRACEPTION

- In a 2025 inquiry with NBCF, ALL asked what kind of research it funds and if it has a statement on abortion and contraception:

ALL followed up with another inquiry specific to its positions on abortion and contraception, but never received a response.

- NBCF's [FAQ page](#) does not condemn or promote the use of oral contraceptives, or mention how significant the linkage is between hormonal contraceptives and breast cancer:

Is there a link between oral contraceptives and breast cancer? There is an increased risk of breast cancer for women who have been using birth control pills for more than five years. However due to the low amount of hormones in birth control pills today, the risk is relatively small. But if a young woman has a significant family history of breast cancer, her gynecologist may recommend taking a break for a year from the pill at the 5-year time frame then resuming again for another 5 years. Although evidence-based research data does not offer strong support for this standard of care, it has nevertheless become an increasingly common practice. Medically reviewed June 2023.

- NBCF [compares seven breast cancer charities](#) on its website, which include the [American Cancer Society](#), which uses human embryonic stem cells in its research, and [Susan G. Komen](#), who supports the same research and has had a relationship with Planned Parenthood. However, NBCF states the following:

If you choose to donate to a smaller, local organization, do some research ahead of time to ensure the organization aligns with your goals and values.

- ALL investigated the medical and office staff members of NBCF. Any of involvement with questionable organizations or with organizations conducting research using human embryonic stem cells have not yet been found.
