## Nevada's Abortion-on-Demand Amendment

This measure would:

- Establish the murder of the preborn child through abortion as a “reproductive right” in Nevada’s constitution. **This would enshrine preborn child killing as state law.**
- Allow abortion on demand through fetal viability (24 weeks).
- Allow lawmakers to add exceptions for preborn child killing post viability (24 weeks) for the life and health of the mother, as determined by providers as a “necessity.”

Nevadans voted YES to this same amendment in 2024. However, Nevada requires that amendments to its constitution be approved in two even-numbered election years. Therefore, this is the second time they will vote on this measure.

### NEVADA’S CURRENT ABORTION LAW:

Nevada allows abortions up through 24 weeks, with exceptions for life and general health of the mother. If the mother is under 18, she can obtain a judicial bypass if her parent or guardian does not sign permission for the abortion.
