- St. Labre Indian School lists “respect” as [one of its values](#):  
*We recognize the sacred worth and dignity of each person. We, therefore, treat individuals—their families and various communities—with profound respect and utmost regard.*
- Its [“Works of Mercy”](#) program is designed for high school students to live the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy within the community. According to its mission statement:  
*Our actions should protect, promote, and defend the dignity of each human person, especially the poor, the vulnerable, the marginalized, the outcast, the suffering, the sick, the exploited, **and the unborn**. This is a key element of the mission of our school.*
- On page 40 of its [high school curriculum](#) description, it introduces high school students to St. John Paul II’s Theology of the Body:  
*Students will also have an introduction to the theology of the Body to understand human love and sexuality in the Plan of God.*
- [In 2023](#) the school refused to permit a male student with gender dysphoria to wear girls’ clothing and refer to him as ‘two-spirit.’
