ALL Fights Amendments That Threaten Life and the Family

American Life League has relaunched its ballot information flyers for the upcoming 2026 state elections. So far, Virginia, Nevada, and Missouri are facing ballot measures in November that either propose enshrining abortion and anti-marriage laws into their state constitutions or limiting abortion to some cases instead of all. The amendments use ambiguous and partisan language to hide their true, dangerous impacts, diminishing both the murder of preborn children in the womb and attacks on the good of the family and the individual within marriage.

These reasons are why ALL has created ballot flyers as FREE resources to reach and teach Christians why we cannot **ever** vote in favor of murdering the innocent and redefining God's design for marriage. These flyers explain not only what these amendments are proposing but what the Church teaches about life and family. We are also encouraging the bishops in each

Troubling Results

New Poll Shows Reality of Americans' Abortion Beliefs

The Knights of Columbus and Marist Institute for Public Opinion released their 2026 abortion survey report, revealing Americans' current beliefs about taking the life of an innocent preborn child through abortion.

The poll found that 64% support legal limits on abortion and 57% support bans on abortions after three months gestation. Respondents supported abortion limits, but only with exceptions for rape, incest, and life of the mother.

While some say these results are good news, we find them troubling. For decades, compromises and exceptions have eroded understanding of the preborn baby's intrinsic value. Americans think abortion needs "limits," and they fail to understand that it is always murder and always evil.

To change hearts and minds on the reality of abortion and the preborn baby, we must acknowledge that this is a spiritual battle, not a political one. Through CLSP, STOPP, and our other endeavors, American Life League will continue to pray and teach why we must defend the human person at all stages of life—no exceptions or compromises.

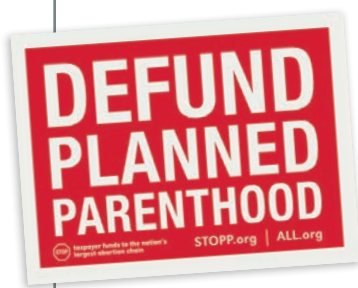

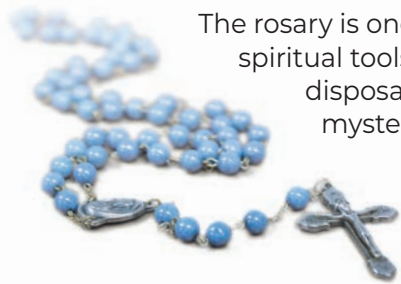

Cardinal Raymond Burke gave a sermon on Epiphany and said in part, "We have, in fact, the treasures of the work of divine grace in our lives to offer Our Lord at every moment.

Uniting our hearts to His glorious-pierced Heart in the Eucharistic sacrifice, we offer all these gifts to Our Lord, gifts which He has first given to us. As Blessed Columba Marmion teaches us: 'On this day, when her mystical nuptials with Christ begin, she [the Church] offers to God no longer gold, frankincense, and myrrh, but the One who is Himself represented by these gifts, immolated upon the altar and received into the hearts of His disciples.'"

Catholic bishops in Colorado wrote a letter to parishioners throughout the state encouraging them to vote according to their Catholic faith. In it, they stated, "May we, as a community of faith, take this important stand for the dignity of the human person, the protection of children and the religious liberty of all."



Bishop Kevin Rhoades (Fort Wayne-South Bend, Indiana), responded to pro-abortion Susan Ostermann declining a position at Notre Dame as director of the Liu Institute for Asia and Asian Studies. He said Notre

Dame's commitment to promoting human life and dignity "is compromised when a Catholic university appoints leaders or bestows honors on those who act or speak against fundamental teachings of the Church."

Jesus Christ clearly and without fear. A Church that forms missionary disciples, not passive spectators. 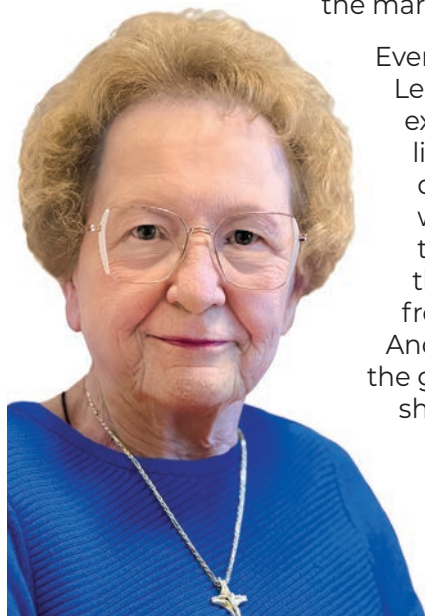

QUESTION & ANSWER

Is it true that Planned Parenthood grooms people to persuade them to cooperate in its deadly work?

Yes. Mayra Rodriguez, a former Planned Parenthood director, says the organization grooms both employees and mothers. An article for *Celebrate Life Magazine* explains, “[Mayra] said that, at the time when she was first hired, women were taken into a room like ‘cattle’ as they waited for their abortions. They were placed in front of a TV playing a video that ‘downplayed’ abortion, and doctors readily dismissed any concerns that they may feel regret.”
